COOKIES

The user is informed that, during his visits to the site, cookies may be automatically installed on his browser software. Google Chrome

In the « Settings » menu, click on « Show advanced settings... », then click on « Content Settings... ». In the top part of the page that appears then are more information about cookies and will have the possibility to select which cookies the user accepts or not. The user also has the possibility to delete all cookies saved so far.

Mozilla Firefox

In the « Tools » menu, click on « Options » (for MAC users, select « Preferences » from the Firefox menu), then go to the tab « Privacy », in the « History » area, deploy the « Retention Rules » drop-down menu and select « Use Custom Settings for History ». The user can then choose whether or not to accept cookies by checking or unchecking the « Accept Cookies » box.

Internet Explorer 6+

In the « Tools » menu, click on « Internet Options », then go to the « Confidentiality » tab. The user can then activate a cursor allowing him to choose among 6 degrees of cookie restriction: Block all cookies, very high restriction, high restriction, medium restriction (selected by default), low restriction and accept all cookies.

Safari

In the Safari menu, select « Preferences », then go to the « Confidentiality » tab. Choose the option of your choice in the « Block Cookies » section.

Other browsers

To find out how to control cookies on other browsers, the user can consult their documentation or online help modules.
